The Parish Council will provide each adult with a £10 voucher and children with a £5 voucher. To claim your voucher, you should email Jayne Power at:

Your email should include, your address and the names of the residents applying for a voucher and whether they are adults or children. The deadline for applications is **5.00pm on Friday 15th August 2025**, vouchers **cannot** be applied for after this date, regardless of circumstances. Once your request has been made you will receive a **confirmation email**. You will then receive the appropriate vouchers directly to your address by **Monday 18th August**.

Please note that if you do not receive an email confirming your order, you should apply in writing to Woodside, Goose Lane, include your phone number so I can confirm receipt.

The following terms apply to the use of your vouchers:

- The voucher can only be redeemed as follows:

Thursday 21st August 4.00pm – 8.30pm

Friday 22nd August 12.00 – 8.30pm

Saturday 23rd August 12.00 - 8.30pm

Sunday 24th August 12.00 – 7.00pm

Monday 25th August 12.00 – 7.00pm

- The voucher can only be redeemed against **Food and Drink** and a table **must** be booked.
- You **must** produce the original voucher on the day, unfortunately if this is not provided the voucher cannot be honoured.
- The vouchers **cannot** be redeemed at any other time and will be void after the dates stated.
- The vouchers can only be redeemed by the person the voucher was issued to; every voucher will be numbered and linked to the address that it was claimed from. The Hatton Arms will hold a list of all issued vouchers.
