We are now actively monitoring traffic volumes, traffic speeds and looking at times when these are particularly problematic. Traffic Issues through the Village

Since the beginning of the road works on the A56, we have had several complaints regarding the rise in accidents and speeding vehicles in and around the village. We asked Cllr Laura Booth to take these concerns to the Highways Department at WBC and this is their response: -

Unfortunately, the local authority does not have the powers to enforce speeding and careless driving. The Police are responsible for this type of enforcement.

Cheshire Police now have a facility on their website for reporting traffic issues. If you continue to experience problems at this location, we would advise that you submit the online form. Cheshire Police will then look at each location with a view to enforcement.
